Langford Lakes received the coveted Chairman's Trophy in the Quarry Products Association 2007 Restoration Awards.



Set in the picturesque Wylye valley to the west of Salisbury, Langford Lakes is one of the UK's best examples of long-term gravel workings that have successfully made the transition to become a stunning nature reserve.

Since purchasing the site in 2001, the Wiltshire Wildlife Trust has built on the good restoration work achieved previously by Hills to establish what has become its flagship reserve.

It is now an important refuge for wetland birds, a centre of excellence for environmental education, a popular destination for anglers and a valued venue for the local community.
